NATIONAL REPRESENTATION CRITERIA

The following criteria have been set for Scouts representing the Association at Regional and International events. The criteria have been established to ensure that there is a known minimum standard for Scouts representing the Association. The criteria will not be lowered on occasions when it exceeds the minimum criteria set by the event's organizers, except for exceptional circumstances. All Scouts representing the Association at Regional and International events will be required to meet the criteria.

Criteria for Regional Events:

- 1. Must have received his Trail Badge (Working on Pathfinder Award).
- 2. Should be in at least his second year of Scouts.
- 3. Must have completed at least ten (10) Proficiency Badges before leaving for the activity, including the Camper's, Camp Cook's and Entertainer's Badges.
- 4. Must have participated regularly in District and National activities for the Scout Section.
- 5. Must be able to comply with any other special requirements set by the Event's co-ordinators.

Criteria for International Events:

- 1. Must have received his Traverse Badge (Working on Chief Scout's Award).
- 2. Should be in at least his third year of Scouts.
- 3. Must have completed at least fifteen (15) Proficiency Badges before leaving for the activity, including the Camper's, Camp Cook's, Cook's and Entertainer's Badges.
- 4. Must have participated regularly in District and National activities for the Scout Section.
- 5. Must be able to comply with any other special requirements set by the Event's co-ordinators.
